

PUBLIC NOTICE of Official General Election Results 2021 and Run-off Information for District 7

To the Tribal Members of The Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma

In accordance with the Chief and Tribal Council Election Ordinance, adopted by CB-124-18 (amended by CB-39-19, CB-88-19).

Notice is Hereby Given, that the period for Contest of Irregularities, Death or Fraud (Article XIX) and Recount (Article XX) ended at 4:30 p.m. on July 14th. There were no contests or recount requests, so the Election Board has officially ended the General Election cycle with the signing of the Official General Election Results (Article XVIII, Section 9). All election results, listed below, have been duly certified by the Election Board and will be communicated to the Bureau of Indian Affairs office:

District 4 Winner: Jess Henry with 617 votes (53.37%).

District 10 Winner: Anthony Dillard with 554 votes (90.67%).

District 7: No candidate received more than 50% of total votes cast and Article XXII, Section 3 requires a Runoff Election to occur. The two candidates that received the most votes will appear on the run-off ballot:

Adrian Johnico with 421 votes (36.67%); and,

Joey Tom with 460 votes (40.07%).

Notice is Hereby Given, that Early Voting will be August 6th from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Runoff Election for District 7 will be August 7th from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. with Same Day Registration offered as an additional service to eligible tribal members to update their voter information. Affiliated voters may choose to vote by mail or vote in person at any open Voting Location listed as such:
