WHEREAS if awarded the Nation will continue the Family Violence Prevention Program and continue to provide domestic violence services for members of the Nation;

WHEREAS the Tribal Council finds it is in the best interest of the Nation to approve application to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for the Family Violence Prevention Grant for FY2023.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the Department of Health and Human Services for the Family Violence Prevention Grant for FY2023.
