A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the University of Florida for Year One of the FY21 Medication Adherence and Cardio-Metabolic Control Indicators among Adult American Indians Receiving Tribal Health Services Subaward.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation") has been awarded a grant from the University of Florida for budget period March 15, 2022 through December 31, 2022, in the amount of \$22,117.00 to better understand obstacles to medication adherence and how to identify diabetic patients that may need additional support as aligned with goals of the Diabetic Wellness Center and pharmacy services. WHEREAS, the federal budget for the University of Florida subaward is \$22,117.00 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds for Year One will be used to model prediction algorithms for patients with good, fluctuating, and poor medication adherence.
