#### IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

#### RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

#### A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** application to the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation for the FY21 Native American Affairs: Technical Assistance to Tribes Grant.

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation (the "Council") realizes the need to assess water supply vulnerability and adopt planning measures to increase drought resiliency throughout the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation") for tribal members and the entire region;

WHEREAS, the Nation is eligible to receive up to \$200,000 for water management, water firm yield studies, and assessing current capacity and intake in the areas of water resources development, management, and protection;

WHEREAS, the Nation will provide a Water Resource Manager to oversee the water studies;

WHEREAS, the Nation will consult with the U.S. Department of Reclamation (Reclamation) to meet established deadlines for the award;

WHEREAS, a voluntary match is accepted but not required; and

WHEREAS, funds from Reclamation will allow the Nation to analyze water firm yield data, current capacity, increased intake, and forecast future water supply needs.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation for the FY 21 Native American Affairs: Technical Assistance to Tribes Grant.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Council that this Bill be cited as an acknowledgement that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing enactments.

### **CERTIFICATION**
