



# SIMPLE BEADED NECKLACE HOW TO

## SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Size 5 or 6 beads for dominate color  
Size 10 or 11 multi colors of white, yellow, orange, red (or 4 other colors)  
Size D thread, size 10 beading needle, clasp and ring closure

1. Measure out 3 wing spans of thread
2. Double thread the needle & tie knot at end of thread
3. Wax thread
4. Tie thread through the bottom of the lobster claw clip (*just like you would on the eye of the earring hook*)
5. String on 15 size 5/6 (large Beads) dominate color beads
6. String on size 10/11 (small beads) multi colors beginning with 3 white, 3 yellow, 3 orange, 3 red
7. String on 1 size 5/6 dominate color
8. String on size 10/11 multi colors beginning with 3 red, 3 orange, 3 yellow, and 3 white
9. Continue with 15 size 5/6 dominate colors
10. Repeat the process with the multi color pattern again
11. Repeat the steps until you have a set of 7 of the size 5/6 dominate colors.

*Note: Measure around your neck to see if you need to go an extra length or if you need to take off a link. Average is 7 sections, but for a choker you might try 6. For a long necklace, keep adding sections until the desired length is achieved.*

12. After you have finished your desired length, run the needle through the jump ring and tie a knot around it. Run the needle through the jump ring 5 times to secure it.
13. After you have looped around the jump ring, take the needle back through the 15 dominate color beads.
14. When you come to the end of the first link of dominate colors string on the multi colors - 3 white, 3 yellow, 3 orange, 3 red to create a double strand of small beads in this section.
15. Run the needle through the 1 dominate color again
16. String on 3 red, 3 orange, 3 yellow, 3 white to create a double strand of small beads in this section.
17. Run the needle through the next set of 15 dominate colors and repeat the multi colors again creating double strands of small beads in each section until you have come back to the beginning of the necklace.
18. Once you come to the beginning of the necklace you will loop around the lobster claw clip a few times and tie a knot to complete.
19. If you have enough thread you could string back through the necklace and add another link of multi colors or you could finish off by tying a knot around the lobster claw clip and run the needle back through half of the 15 dominate colors and cut the thread.
